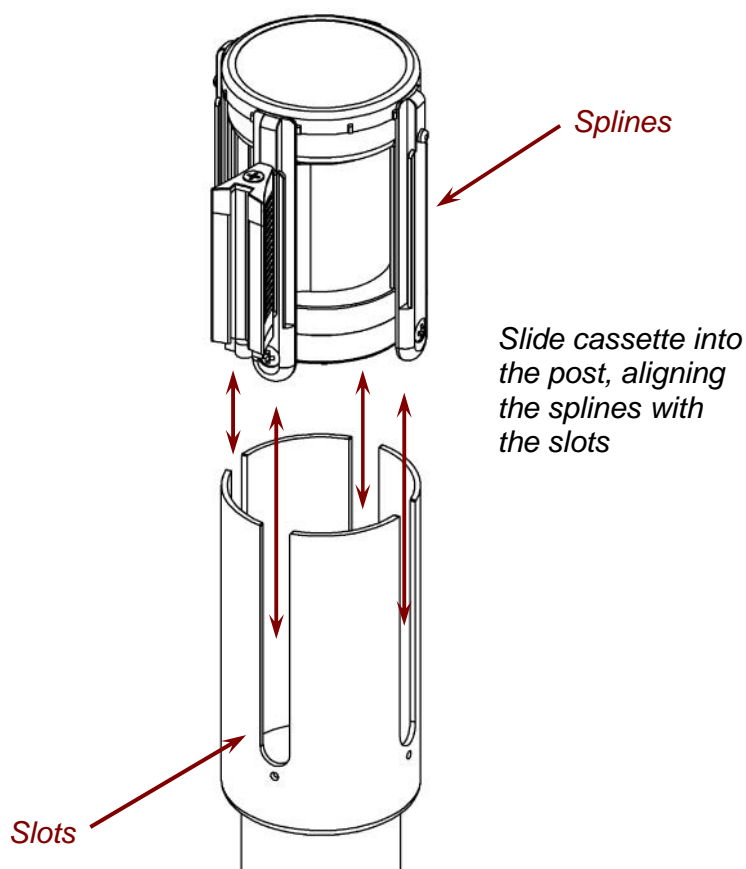
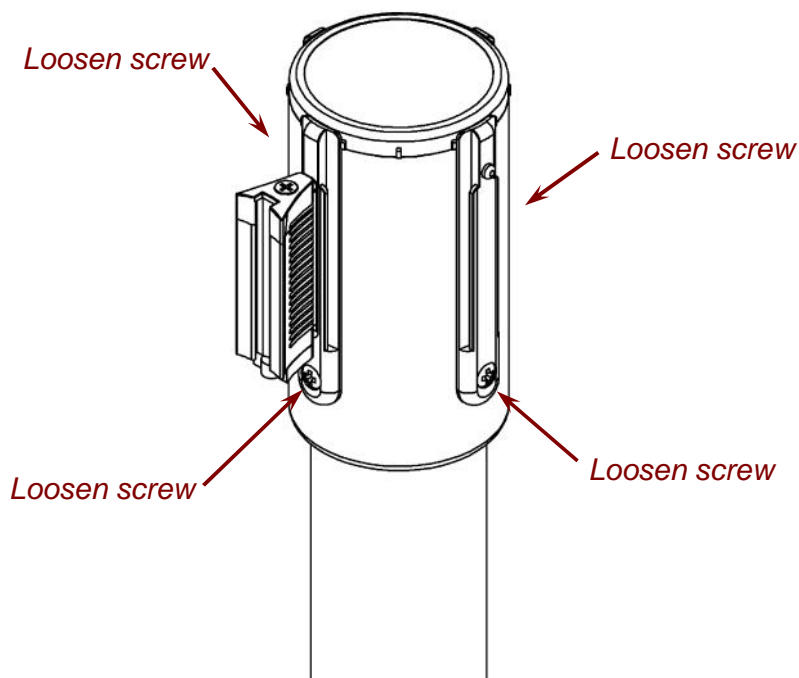


Replacing a cassette:



Tools required:

- Phillips head screwdriver

How to replace a cassette:

- Step #1:
Using a Phillips head screwdriver, loosen the four screws located at the bottom of the splines. Do not remove the four screws.
- Step #2:
Release the cassette from the post by pulling outward carefully on each spline which will loosen them from the post. Lift the cassette upward and off of the post.
- Step #3:
Slide the new cassette into the top of the post. Align the four splines with the four slots in the top of the post. The splines slide outside the post while the cassette slides inside the post. Jiggle the cassette slightly left to right to assist in the insertion
- Step #4:
Press the top of the cassette to fully seat the cassette.
- Step #5:
Using a Phillips head screwdriver, tighten the four screws at the bottom of the splines to secure the new cassette into place.

Your post is now ready to use.
